Vision/Search Committee update – The Committee is diligently working on our “Church Unique” process. We have met together for three long, intense sessions on Sunday afternoons. On June 22, we were joined by about 50 to 60 members of the congregation for a verbal update and the opportunity to participate in some questions and answers as part of our Vision process. In the past, mission statements for most churches contained many words (our own current one has 68 words). Today’s mission statements tend to be more like “sound bites.” Everyone in our congregation should be able to recite it and use it to tell people about Pilgrim Church. The statement should meet a five-fold criteria – clear, concise, compelling, catalytic and contextual. We expect to have another meeting with the congregation by the end of the summer.
